ADVICE FOR MANAGING YOUR COURSE LOAD

- For the working adult we recommend a maximum of 3 courses for semesters 1 & 2 and no more than 2 in summer.

- The **core YDEW** courses are 100% continuous assessment (do not carry final examinations)

- Semesters 1 and 2 each have 13-14 weeks of tuition
- Summer has 7-9 weeks of tuition
