- The **core YDEW** courses are 100% continuous assessment (do not carry final examinations)

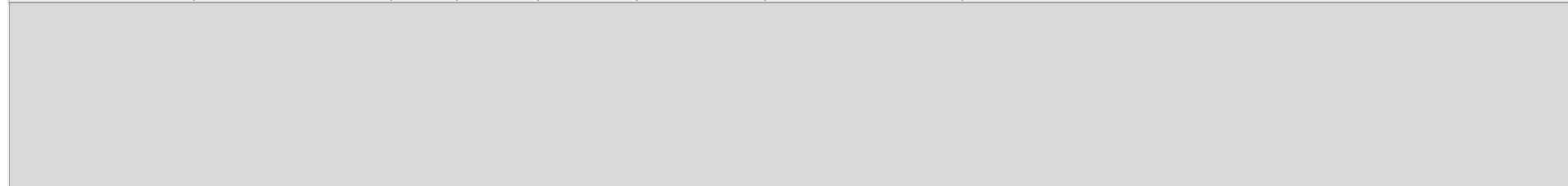
Note:
