ADVICE FOR MANAGING YOUR COURSE LOAD

- **Foundation** courses have a final face-to-face exam
- The **core Social Work** courses are 100% continuous assessment (do not carry final examinations)

- Semesters 1 and 2 each have 13-14 weeks of tuition
- Summer has 7-9 weeks of tuition
