ADVICE: For the working adult we recommend a maximum of 3 courses for the semester and no more than 2 in summer.

Note:

- Semester has 13-14 weeks of tuition
- Summer has 7-9 weeks of tuition

- **STUDENTS TAKING THE DIPLOMA:**
- Must complete a minimum of 45 credits (Core courses: 37 credits; Electives: 8 credits) ; or a maximum of 60 credits (Core courses: 37; Electives: 23 credits)
- ‘Specially Admitted’ students are allowed a total of 12 credits in an academic year and no more than 24 credits in total.
